BOOTH CATEGORIES

Non-Profit Organizations – Any organization which can provide proof of non-profit status with this application. If selling food or beverages see the **Food Booth** description below.

Crafters – Homemade products only – **non-food**. Original hand-crafted work in any media by the artist who is present.

Business – licensed business, resale manufactured products.

Dam Road Businesses – **REMINDER** – If you do not send in an application and fee, the Stroll Committee will place another booth in front of your store on the street. All sidewalks must remain clear per Contra Costa County requirements. A SPECIAL RATE OF \$100.00 FOR BUSINESSES ON THE DAM ROAD.

Food Booth – Commercial or non-profit groups selling or sampling foods/beverages prepared on or off-site for immediate or later consumption. Must comply with County Health Department requirements including completion of a Health Department package supplied from the Chamber. Non-profit organizations, Veteran owned businesses, Mobile Food Vehicles and Cottage Food operators are exempt ONLY IF YOU SUPPLY DOCUMENTATION OF YOUR EXEMPTION to the Chamber when submitting your applications. [DD214, 501(c)3, VALID Health Permits]

PARADE NOTES

Line up – Parade begins at 11:00 am. Line up starts at 10:00 am at the Walgreen's parking lot, but location may be subject to change. The parade line begins at the drive-thru pharmacy and goes behind the building.

Parking – VENDORS will receive a packet from the Chamber with road access for set up and parking locations One week prior to the Stroll.

The Walgreens parking lot is NOT for parade participant parking. Walgreen's is still open for business, and any parking should be SHORT TERM. We appreciate Walgreen's for letting us use their lot. Usually, public parking is available at the Masonic Lodge lot, alongside streets (please respect other people's property) **and at both the Moose Lodge on Appian Way and the Park 'n Ride lot on Hilltop Drive at the I-80 exit with a Stroll Shuttle available between these two lots and the entrance to the stroll at the Appian Way intersection.**

CANCELLATION POLICY

Weather - No cancellation for weather—the stroll goes on rain or shine.
